Guilherme Marchi took the 2008 season by storm and, after taking on the best bulls in the world, he took the lead in points at the beginning of the year and never gave it up. In 2008, Marchi rode his way to five event wins, fifteen top 5 finishes, and nineteen top 10 finishes. He also broke the record for most scored rides in a single season by riding 74 bulls, finishing the season with a 75% riding percentage. Marchi continued his consistent riding into 2009 where claimed two BFTS event titles in Kansas City, Mo., and Springfield, Mo. In a title race closer than any other in history, Marchi battled Kody Lostroh and J.B. Mauney all season, ultimately coming in third in the World in Las Vegas.

The Brazilian wonder began his bull riding career ten years ago and broke onto the PBR scene in 2004. After finishing runner-up to the World Champion for three years in a row, Marchi was determined to not let it happen again. He left the 2008 PBR Built Ford Tough World Finals with the ultimate title---the 2008 PBR World Championship and the \$1,000,000 bonus. He also won the 2008 90-Point Club Bonus with 13 90-point rides. One of the most consistent riders in PBR history, Marchi has logged a career riding percentage of over 60%, has competed in 150 events - winning 12 of them, and has scored 36 90-point plus rides.
